Rahmat means "Mercy"

or compassion or forgiveness shown toward someone whom it is within one's power to punish or harm.

Month 6 RAHMAT

here is a Holy Day in the month of Rahmat. The Martyrdom of The Dáb begins at noon on the 17th day. On this day, Bahá'ís around the world gather together to show their respect for the Báb. The Báb was a Messenger of God who prepared the world for Bahá'u'lláh.

Shrine of the Báb

The Martyrdom of The Báb is honored on the 17th day of Rahmat. On this Holy Day, Bahá'ís gather together to remember The Báb. The Báb was a Manifestation of God. Manifestations of God bring messages to help humanity live according to God's laws. The Báb taught us how to love God. He gave His life to help others get ready for the next Manifestation of God, Bahá'u'lláh. The word "Báb" means "Gate" in Arabic.

People often heard The Báb chant His short prayer and would be overcome with emotion. Some of those people would even start to cry. This was because they could see how much The Báb loved God.

The Báb was full of love for God. This was true in the happiest of times and in the hardest of times.

Even when the Báb was imprisoned in a cold mountain fortress, he was full of love for God.

"O God, my God, my Beloved, my heart's Desire." ~ The Báb

The Báb called that mountain, 'Grievous Mountain'. He was imprisoned there by the government after he declared himself to be a messenger from God. The leaders did not believe him. Even when these leaders ordered that The Báb be killed, He was full of love for God.

After The Báb was killed, or martyred, Bahá'u'lláh and the Bahá'ís protected His remains for nearly

60 years. During those 60 years, the followers started to build a mausoleum for remains of The Báb. Mausoleums are buildings specially built to honor and protect the remains of very important people. The mausoleum for The Báb is called the Shrine of The Báb and it was built on Mount Carmel in Haifa, Israel. It is beautiful and has a golden dome. Some call it the Queen of Carmel because of its golden crown.

The Báb's love for God continues to shine when we read His Writings. Let's say His short prayer together.



Gems Arts & Crafts Rain Cloud Mobile!

This craft was inspired by Easy Peasy and Fun! pinterest.com/easypeasyandfun/

You will need

- blue paper
 yellow paint
 yarn (white or
- white paper
 glue
 blue
- cotton balls
 clear tape
 paint brush
- paper plate
 scissors

What to do

- 1. Paint the paper plate yellow like the sun. Allow the paint to dry completely.
- While the paint is drying, you can work on the cloud and the rain drops.
- Cut a cloud shape out of white construction paper. You can draw it with a pencil first if you like.
- Next, cut a bunch of raindrops out of the blue paper. We used 14.
- Cut several strings of yarn, about three times as long as your cloud is tall. We used 4 strings.
- Attach the ends of the yarn to the back of the cloud with clear tape. Space them away from each other, enough so the drops will not touch when your craft is hung up.
- 7. Space the drops out and tape them to the yarn.
- 8. Is your plate dry yet? If it is, cut the edges of your plate to make sun rays. Trim a little bit of the sun off. This area will be hidden behind the cloud. This will make the next step easier.
- 9. Glue the cloud to the sun.
- 10. Apply a generous amount of glue to the cloud.
- 11. Stick cotton balls to the gluey cloud to make your cloud fluffy!
- 12. Hang your mobile and enjoy!












Watermelon Trees!

You will need


- A ripe watermelon
- A big knife to cut watermelon
- A smaller knife
- Popsicle Sticks (optional)
- Flavored yogurt (optional)

What to do

- 1. Get and adult to help with cutting if necessary.
- 2. Safely cut large round slices of watermelon.
- 3. Then cut the round slices in to triangle shapes.
- 4. Options:
 - Using the tip of a smaller knife, create a slit in the rind, just wide enough for a popscicle stick to be pushed into it. Press the popsicle stick in to the slit.
 - Cut part of the rind off of each end of the triangle. The remaining rind is now a popsicle stick!
 - Dribble drops of flavored yogurt onto your tree for an extra sweet decoration!
